TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS FOR SENIORS: HELPING TO BRIDGE THE DIGITAL DIVIDE

Older adults may now apply to receive a free iPad with data plan included, as well as training to setup their devices, and access to an online subscription to GetSetUp for virtual classes.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Must be age 60+ and reside in Orange County
- Must have annual gross income less than \$75k
- Must have at least one risk factor for isolation - Live alone, Live in a Care Facility, Health Issue, Limited Mobility, Functional Disability, Limited English Skills.
