## **OC Office on Aging Receives 2024 NACo Awards**

The OC Office on Aging was recognized at the OC Board of Supervisors meeting on August 27, 2024, for earning 2024 NACo Awards for two key programs: Access to Technology (ATT) and Senior Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (SNEMT).

The ATT program helps reduce isolation and increase access to services by providing older adults and individuals with disabilities with digital devices and training. The SNEMT program ensures older adults have reliable transportation to medical appointments, enhancing access to healthcare and overall well-being. Together, these programs aim to improve the quality of life for Orange County's older adults.

## **Share Your Thoughts on OCTA's Transportation Plan**

The Orange County Transportation Authority (OCTA) Human Services Transportation Coordinated Plan is open for public comment through September 6, 2024. Every four years, OCTA develops this plan to identify transportation needs and improve access for older adults, people with disabilities, those with low incomes, limited English proficiency, and anyone without access to a private vehicle.

Making sure older adults have access to essential healthcare services is a key part of our commitment to the community. Access to regular medical care is crucial for maintaining health and well-being, especially for our older adult population. We're here to support our older adults and ensure no one misses out on the care they need due to transportation challenges.

Our Senior Non-Emergency Medical Transportation (SNEMT) program is a vital service that helps older adults get to their medical appointments. This program is designed for older adults who don't have the means or ability to travel to appointments on their own. By removing this barrier, SNEMT ensures older adults can keep up with essential medical visits, helping to prevent minor issues from turning into major health concerns.
